HOW TO SET UP & CLOSE YOUR GORILLA DRUM FOR USE

Steel Drum Strong — Lightweight, Flexible/Foldable Form

Preparing to use Gorilla Drum is quick, easy, and can be completed in just six steps without any assistance or tools. Follow these instructions to successfully set up and close your drum, and to ensure safe storage and transport of your hazardous materials.

STEP 1



Lift the top lid to access the 6 mil. inner plastic line

STEP 2



Full extend inner liner to maximum height

STEP 3



Pull liner completely down around the perimeter of the Gorilla Drum™

STEP 4



Fill the Gorilla Drum™ with hazmat solids only. Designed for materials in Packing Groups I, II, & III – Rating “X”.

Capacity: 453 lbs.

Safety Factor: 6:1

STEP 5



Pull the liner above the bag to maximum height. Gather the liner, rotate clockwise twice, and close with the 16” resealable zip tie (*provided with the unit*)

STEP 6



Close the top lid. Then, use the zipper to secure the contents inside the drum

HOW TO TRANSPORT YOUR GORILLA DRUM

With Gorilla Drum's tough, **flexible belly band** and **UN rated lifting straps**, you can easily and safely transport the drum throughout your facility using a dolly or forklift.

STEP 1



STEP 2



USING A TWO-WHEEL CART OR DOLLY

STEP 1

Fully open **2" wide belly band** (attached to Gorilla Drum) and insert 2-wheel cart or dolly

STEP 2

Secure Gorilla Drum to the cart with belly band using the double-sided Velcro closure



USING A FORKLIFT

Use the forklift tines to evenly lift Gorilla Drum by the provided **2" wide x 16" high** lifting straps
